

The divine revelation concerning salvation should be mastered by every child of God.

- 1) Personal salvation depends on it.
- 2) It is the one message which God has committed to the believer to proclaim to the world.
Romans 1:16-17

3) It alone discloses the full measure of God's love. Ephesians 3:19

* A) Salvation represents the whole work of God by which He rescues man from eternal ruin, doom of sin. (Jonah 2:9)

B) Salvation is God's remedy for sin.

- 1) Sin is always equally sinful (Luke 12:47-48)
- 2) Sin can only be cured through the shed blood of God Son
(Leviticus 4:20, 26, 31, 35, Numbers 15:25, Colossians 1:14, Ephesians 1:7)

The sinner who places their faith in Christ has not only been forgiven, but is justified forever.
(Romans 3:24, 1st Peter 2:24, 3:18)

C) Salvation before and after the cross (Acts 17:30)

- 1) The method of dealing with sin (before) the cross (Hebrew 10:4), Lev 1:4)
- 2) The method of dealing with sin (after) the cross (Romans 3:26)
- 3) To accept the work Christ has done for us, is to believe upon the Savior to the saving of our soul (1st Peter 2:24)

D) The three tenses of Salvation:

- 1) The past tense of Salvation (Luke 7:50, Ephesians 2:5-8, Romans 8:1)
- 2) The present tense of Salvation (Romans 6:14, Galatians 2:19-20)
- 3) The future tense of salvation (Romans 8:29, 1st John 3:2)

E) Salvation the finishing work of Christ (John 19:30)

F) Salvation the saving work of God (Ephesians 2:19, Colossians 2:10)

Every child of God has been delivered from the power of darkness into His marvelous light.

G) Salvation as related to sin.

- 1) Forgiveness of sin accomplished (John 19:30)
- 2) The divine dealing with sin (1st John 1:9)

H) Salvation is through Faith alone

(John 1:12, Romans 1:16, Galatians 3:22, Ephesians 2:4-6)
