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When we fail to listen to God we will often listen to the wrong voice. (Genesis 2:15-17)

When we fail to listen to God we make excuses for our wrong. (Genesis 3:8-9)

When we fail to listen to God we suffer consequences. (Genesis 3:14-15)

When we fail to listen to God we hurt others. (Adam & Eve cursed the entire human race)

When we fail to listen to God we miss God's very best. (Moses, Deuteronomy 32:48-52)

1) How does God speak to His people today, after he has said all we need to know through his word from Genesis to Revelation?

## Why does God speak?

a) <u>First</u>: He desires to fellowship with us. Just as well as he did in the Old Testament days.

1 John 3:1-3) (John 15:7, John 17:20-23)

- b) <u>Second:</u> How could we have a fellowship with him if there is no communication between the two? (Amos 3:1-2)
- c) <u>Third:</u> God know that we need the comfort and assurance he has to provide for his own. (Isaiah 51:11-12, 15,16) (Romans 15:4-6)

\*\*We have our own Red Sea experiences. We undergo failures\*\*

\*\*\*The most important reason God is still talking today is that he wants us to know him. \*\*\*

2) If God is still talking, how does he speak?

First: How did he speak in the Old Testament?

- a) He spoke by divine revelation (Genesis 12:1-2).
- b) He spoke through dreams (Daniel 7:1-3)
- c) He spoke through his written word (The Ten Commandments). The Law to communicate to his people (Exodus 20).

**Second:** How did he speak in New Testament Era /Bible days?

- a) He spoke through Angles (Luke 1:26-28)
- b) He spoke to Saul of Tarsus (Acts 9:1-4).

## **How does God speak today?**

\*\*\*Through the Word of God! \*\*\*

God's Word was written to the people addressed in scripture. The scriptures were also written for us. 2 Timothy 3:16)

The Bible is our way of communication with God and God to us. It also can be our instruction guide for life. (Joshua 1:7-8)

The Holy Spirit....without him we cannot sense the channel of communication to God. (Romans 8:26)

**Other people (Acts 10:17-22)** 

**Circumstances (Psalms 51:1-4)**

## **Identifying the Voice of God**

(Matthew 16:21-22)

There is a difference between the voice of God and Satan.

How can we know for sure that it is God's voice we hear? (John 10:27)

Consistent with the Word!
 If we neglect the Word of God, Satan can too easily deceive us.
 (The voice of God will never violate the scripture)

Conflict with Human wisdom.What we may think is wise to us, may not be to God! (Isaiah 55:8)

- 3. Challenge to Faith: God challenges our faith to build our relationship with Him. (Mark 9:23-24)
- 4. Clash with the fleshly nature.

  God speaks in such a way the pleases the Spirit of God within us and not the flesh.

  (Romans 8 8-10)
- 5. An act of courage: Being bold for the Lord (Joshua 1:6-9)
- 6. Patience: God will never tell us to rush into anything blindly, but Satan will. (Psalms 27:14, 62:5)
