

Question how do we know for sure when God manifest Himself? [John 11:40](#), [Hebrews 11:6](#)

Let us establish the seriousness of the manifestation of God.

[Exodus 20:40-41](#), [Ezekiel 28:22](#), [John 20:31](#),

How does He manifest Himself today?

[Jeremiah 3:15](#), [Ephesians 4:11-16](#), [Romans 10:12-16](#), [2 Timothy 4:1-3](#),

How will this be possible? Because they will believe a lie over the truth. [Galatians 3:1](#)

Paul was concerned that after his death, false teachers would arise in Ephesus and turn believers from the true faith into error and myths.

The first two concern this verse are.

First, people would grow tired of the true gospel and reject it. Instead, they would turn away from the truth looking to replace sound or healthy teaching.

This is to be expected when the gospel message begins with a humbling, difficult thought: we are imperfect and in need of saving.

Second, instead of following godly teachers, people would choose to follow teachers who told them what they liked to hear, rather than what was true. The idea of "[itching ears](#)" may be that of twitching or moving ears that is seeking something different from the traditional, true gospel message.

How was God the Father manifested through the Son?
