We are living in a generation of murmurers. <u>Murmur</u> means to be headstrong, highminded to complain and grumble in a low voice. Those who secretly stir up trouble. <u>Matthew 7:15-23</u>

Where do mummering come from? Mark 7:21-23

Murmurers are often unforgiving, ruthless, and self-seeking they often engage in backbiting and slander while distorting and misrepresenting the truth. <u>Matthew 12:36, 1 Peter 3:16, Proverbs 10:18, James 4:1</u>

Every Christians must be extremely careful when it comes to murmuring because it is extremely dangerous. <u>Philippians 2:12-15</u>,

Complaining and murmuring does not give God glory. What it does is drive people away from God and it is also rebelling against the Lord. <u>1 Peter 4:8-10</u>

From Scripture God hates murmuring. James 5:9,

Why is it so dangerous to murmur? murmuring is a sin.

(1) It deteriorates your faith. <u>1 Timothy 4:1</u>

(2) It does nothing but causes unneeded stress. <u>Philippians 4:6</u>, <u>James 1:2-4</u>

(3) It gives Satan an opportunity to sneak in. It opens us up to his many lies. <u>1 Peter 5:8</u>

We must be careful of those who can have a bad influence over us. <u>Romans 1:29-31</u>, <u>Numbers 11:4-10</u>, <u>Numbers 14:26-30</u>

This is a good example of what <u>spiritual leaders</u> have to deal with although the people themselves do not realize they were mummering against the Lord. <u>Exodus 16:7-10, 1 Samuel 8:7, John 7:12-13, John 7:31-32 John 6:41-42</u>,

Murmuring is contentious; it tests the Lord Exodus. 15:24 17:3-7

Murmurers are rebellious Deuteronomy.1:26-27

Murmurers pay a penalty for rebelling against the Lord Num. 14:2, 29; Psalm 101:5

Murmurers do not heed the word of God (Psalm. 106:25).
