Let us see what the Old Testament say about who God is. Jeremiah 52:27, Isaiah 44:6 Numbers 22:19.

God said it I believe it, Acts 12:1-6, John 21:18-19, Matthew 29:31-35, Matthew 26:69-75

How do we come to know our Lord and Savior intimately? Matthew 11:28-29 Hebrews 11:6.

It is only when we get closer to Him that we get a glimpse of His awesomeness.

Adonai: Meaning "Lord" or "Master"

Elohim: Meaning "God" or "gods"

Yahweh: Meaning "I AM WHO I AM" or "the LORD"

Ei Olam: Meaning "The everlasting God" or "the eternal God"

Ei Roi: Meaning "The God who sees"

Ei Shaddai: Meaning "God Almighty" or "God the All-Powerful"

Jehovah: Meaning "The LORD," "the Self-Existent One," or "the Eternal One"

Jehovah: JIREH Meaning "The LORD will provide"

Jehovah: ROPHE Meaning "The Lord Who Healeth thee"

Let us see what the New Testament say about who Jesus is.

The seven statements are:

I am the bread of life John 6:35

I am the light of the world John 8:12

I am the gate John 10:7

I am the good shepherd John 10:11, 14

I am the resurrection and the life John 11:25

I am the way and the truth and the life John 14:6

I am the true vine John 15:1-5

Jesus identifies Himself as God John 10:30, Exodus 3:14
