

“Faithfulness” Pt 2
Lamentations 3:23

Faithfulness can be defined as, a lasting loyalty, trustworthiness relationship, especially in marriage and friendship: [Genesis 2:8-9, 15-17, 24](#)

Faithful is also used in the sense of “believing,” as in the case of the Christians in Ephesus and Colossae [Ephesians 1:1](#); [Colossians 1:2](#).

When God **creates** anything for the purpose of serving Him, He expects those created things to be faithful towards Him. [Genesis 1:1](#), [Isaiah 6:3](#), [2 Corinthians 5:17](#)

We know that sin separated man from God but that never stop Him from loving us. [Romans 5:8](#), [Romans 8:35](#) [Ephesians 5:25](#),

To be faithful is to be willing to follow where God leads the believer. [Psalm 37:23](#)

The steps of a man are established by the Lord, when he delights in his way; The heart of man plans his way, but the Lord establishes his steps.

God words is given to us so that we abide by it according to our faithfulness. [John 15:4-6](#).

When we make the choice not to abide God’s law no matter who it might come from especially the preacher, we have to be careful. [Hosea 4:6](#), [Luke 10:16](#) **amp**

God is eternally reliable, steadfast, and unwavering because faithfulness is one of His inherent attributes.

God does not have to work at being faithful; He *is* faithful. **Faithfulness** is an essential part of who He is [Hebrews 13:8](#). [Psalm 89:8](#);

In His faithfulness,

God protects us from evil ([2 Thessalonians 3:3](#)),

Sets limits on our temptations ([1 Corinthians 10:13](#)),

Forgives us of sin ([1 John 1:9](#)), and sanctifies us ([1 Corinthians 1:9](#); [Philippians 1:6](#)).

God is faithful and faithful to His children ([Matthew 25:23](#)).
