Now Faith Is:

Scripture Lesson: Hebrews 11:1-3

What is Faith?

Faith comes by hearing the word of God (Acts 2:37-41, Romans 10:17).

Now Faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen (Hebrews 11:1-6)

We are saved by Faith (Ephesians 2:5-8) It takes FAITH to please God. (Hebrews 11:6)

By <u>FAITH</u> if God says it, we should believe it! Abraham believed by FAITH (Romans: 17-25) (2nd Corinthians 5:7) (Hebrews 10:38)

Faith must be a sure thing in our life. It should be a firm conviction, producing a full acknowledgement of God's revelation of truth

(1st Thessalonians 2:11-13) (1st John 5:14)

There should be no room for doubt when it comes to our belief in God on faith (James 1:5-8) (Matthew 14:31) (Matthew 6:30) (Luke12:28)

God knows us, so we must be honest with him about our Faith. (Mark 9:17-25) (John 9:35) (John 11:14-16, 24-25, 38-40).

Do all men have FAITH? (2nd Thessalonians 3:2) (Romans 12: 3-6 a measure of faith here can be a translated *met'-ron*) a limited portion of gifts.

The way that Faith can grow in our lives

- a) Continue in Faith (Acts 14:22)
- b) Stand fast in FAITH (1st Corinthians 13:13,16:13)
- c) Be strong in FAITH (2nd Corinthians 8:7)
- d) Pray for an increase of FAITH (Luke 17:5)
- e) Have assurance of FAITH (2nd Timothy 1:12)
- f) Be grounded in FAITH (Colossians 1:23)
- g) Die in FAITH (Hebrews 11:13)
