If I were to ask the question "what is your sign how would you respond"?

If a loved one or close friend offends you in a way that severely hurts your feelings again how would that make you feel? <u>John 3:16</u>

How did it make you feel when a loved one preceded you in death, or how do you think they would feel if you preceded them in death? Jesus did just that Romans 5:8, John 19:25-29

So, when we offend God or disappoint Him how do you think that makes Him feel? **Ephesians 4:30** 

The meaning to this is to cause "pain or to make sad."

Jesus never intended drinking poison or handling snakes to be a specific test or measure of faith. Romans 12:6-8

### The evidence or proof of these gifts

## Spoke in other tongues

This was both a miracle (a miracle upon the mind), for the confirming of the truth of the gospel, and a means of spreading the gospel among those nations that had not heard it. <a href="Luke 10:19"><u>Luke 10:19</u></a>

These signs shall follow them that belief. Not that all who believe, shall be able to produce these signs, but some, <u>Acts 2:4, Act 19:6</u> <u>1 Corinthians 14:22</u>

### Casting out demons Acts 16:16-18

Handling snakes Acts 28:1-6, Acts 20:7-12, Acts 5:12-14.

Before these things happen, Exodus 4:2-3, Exodus 7:8-13

#### **Healing the sick James 5:14-16**

My question about this passage is since we don't see many Christian believers performing in these manners, what did Jesus mean by this if we should be taking this literally?

I believe this is a solemn declaration of that true faith which receives Christ in all his characters and offices, and for all the purposes of salvation.
