Question: how many of you really want to go to heaven and why?

Before any of us can plan to go to heaven sin must be dealt with. <u>Matthew 9:12–13</u>, <u>John 3:17</u> <u>1 Corinthians 15:55-58.</u>

If we are not careful about what God's word has commanded us to get rid of from our lives, they can cause us to become <u>separated</u> from Him and cause death. <u>Genesis 2:15-17</u>, <u>Romans 6:23</u>

Pastors if I sin then why am I still alive Lamentations 3:22-23, 2 Peter 3:8-10

When we sin, God is fair when He judge us. Psalm 51

Most of the time when a believer sins it produces "Fear:" within that individual. <u>Genesis 3:6-10</u> <u>Ezekiel 18:20</u>

<u>Here's food for thought</u>: did you all know that unified unbelievers are more powerful than divided believers. <u>Matthew 12:22-30</u>

Here's another nugget, being impatient can drive you in the hands of other gods. Exodus 24:12-18, Exodus 32:12-18,

There will be times you people will leave you because of who you are in Christ. <u>2Timothy 4:10-18</u>.

This gives us hindsight of the meaning "back- stabbers"

Back-stabbers are those who become jealous of you being out front. Genesis 37:5-18

Jesus came that we all would come to know Him Matthew 11:28-29
