I need us to stay focus today, because you are going to do the work.

Both prayers consist of the same principle.

#1 Acknowledging God

#2 Acknowledging His Holiness

#3 We are to seek His Will when asking for daily provisions.

#4 Seek forgiveness, guidance, and protection.

As powerful as prayer is, there is one thing that prayer, faith, or anything else can't do. Prayer cannot supersede or override the will of God. 1 John 5:14-15, John 16:23-33

QUESTION: what is prayer?

Prayer is a solemn request for help or expression of thanks addressed to God:

Prayer is also spiritual communication between man and God, a two-way relationship in which man should not only talk to God but also listen to Him. Psalm 91:15, Isaiah 65:24, Matthew 7:7

According to Matthew 6:25-34 why do we need to pray? Luke 18:1, 1 Thessalonians 5:17, Philippians 1:6

Jesus teaches us the order of how and what to do when we need to pray. Matthew 6:6, James 5:16

QUESTION: what does prayer mean to you?

Prayer is knowing when you can't God can. Matthew 19:26

We pray to align our hearts with God and to seek His guidance in the 1 Samuel 30:8-15

QUESTION: how important is prayer? 2 Chronicles 7:14

The early church prayed over each other for healing James 5:14-15

QUESTION: Is there power in prayer? John 11:38-44, Acts 12:5, James 1:5, Philippians 1:9-10.

The Reality of prayer is it works.

If there is a key to experiencing power in prayer, it is making sure you pray from a place of reality. What I mean by this is that you don't hide the truth of your situation and how you feel about it.

The truth is the only way to grow in prayer is by praying.
